Taking Logs from Selsdon Wood – A month ago we were approached by someone who wanted some logs to build a treehouse. We knew we are not in a position to give such permission, so we forwarded the request to the Council who replied as follows:

"Thank you for your e mail to the Friends of Selsdon Wood, which they have forwarded to me. Unfortunately, we cannot give permission for you to take wood from the woods. We get numerous requests from people wanting to take wood from all of Croydon's woods for various reasons. If we allowed it for one, we would have to allow it for all and we would not be able to control it, resulting in dead wood habitat being removed, not to mention the health and safety risks and liability issues. Good luck in your search for logs and building your tree house."

Wood Carvings Project – Alasdair Craig's carvings of the Owls and the Green Man (see photo) have been so loved by all that our JustGiving page to raise money for more of them reached the target of £1,200 in little over a month. We have thus commissioned Alasdair to carve another sylvan scene, which he started on 1st May. If this proves equally popular, we hope to commission more and eventually to have enough carvings to make a special trail.

April Work Sessions – Much of the work this month has involved planting on the Butterfly Bank and around the Linden Glade pool. Our teams have cleared away some of the grass, dug over the soil, added fertiliser to the chalk and planted more native flowering species. These will now be tended and watered until they are established.

An additional job was clearance of the pavement access to the car park and the dropped kerb at the end. This was undertaken in response to a report from the user of a mobility scooter who had found it impossible to gain access to the wood via the footpath. We hope that prams and mobility scooters will now be able to use the path and dropped kerb ramp.
